Sector Spotlight

In this month's sector spotlight we turn our attention to Oil & Gas, a sector that Haworth Castings have been serving for over 20 years. An Important Day For BP

"This is an important day for Azerbaijan and BP as it marks the beginning of our bilateral cooperation in exploration and development of a new offshore block", stated Bob Dudley, BP's new Chief Executive.

BP & SOCAR (Azerbaijans state energy company) have announced they had signed a new production sharing agreement on joint exploration and development of the Shafag-Asiman structure in the Caspian sea. The Shafag-Asiman block covers an area of around 1,100 square kilometres (400sq miles) and has never been explored. The field is estimated to contain 300-500 billion cubic meters of gas, making it one of Azerbaijan's largest. With pipelines into Europe this could ease the reliance upon Russian energy for the EU.

Whilst BP's reputation is still at an all time low and the last dividend not paid, expansion in new and emerging economies throughout the world could help accelerate the brand building process.
